EDITH DeBUSK PRESIDENT'S AWARD

The Award

A \$50 cash award and a commemorative plaque suitable for display in home or office will be presented at each annual District Conference. Runners up will be presented a District Nine Certificate of Merit.

Objectives

To encourage the development of leadership, motivating clubs and club members to achieve their maximum potential for service.

Eligibility

Any President of any club in District Nine for the year ending May 31 preceding the annual District Conference. In order to be considered, a signed copy of the Club Activity Report that was sent to the District designate and to International and a copy of the oral annual report presented to the club at its annual meeting in May must be submitted as the entry (No other attachments will be considered.)

The entry in triplicate should be mailed to the Immediate past Governor who serves as Chairman of the Awards committee. The entry must be postmarked not later than June 1 preceding the Conference

Criteria

The judging of this award shall follow the established criteria. Entries will be judged on:

- a. Evidence of adherence to established policies and procedure of Altrusa International, Inc.
- b. Effective utilization of official materials.
- c. Accomplishment of goals set and activities undertaken.
- d. Quality and quantity of membership participation.
- e. Efforts toward membership growth and retention

Awards Committee

The committee shall consist of four (4) members. The Chairman shall be the Immediate Past Governor. The Governor shall designate the other three members. Each committee's term of office will correspond with that of the Governor. The winner of the award each year shall be decided by majority vote of the committee, whose decision shall be final. The name of the winner shall be kept secret within the committee and announced only at the presentation at the District Conference.
